



### **PENINSULA FILM FESTIVAL 2020**

Peninsula Film Festival 2020 will be held from Friday January 31, 2020 – Sunday February 2, 2020 with the free short film festival held on Saturday February 1, 2020 at the Village Green in Rosebud, Mornington Peninsula.

Once again we are inviting filmmakers of any level to submit a short film of up to eight minutes in length (including credits).

Films can be about any subject but those of a defamatory or deemed unsuitable by selectors will be disqualified at their discretion. If your film is shortlisted, it will be screened on the night to an audience expected to reach more than 8,000 people. Your film may also be screened at a later stage at Melbourne's Federation Square and other 'pop up' cinemas and PFF activations. Your film will be judged on the evening by a panel of industry professionals.

### **FILMMAKERS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:**

- Your film can be up to eight minutes in length including credits, not over.
- Your film must be no older than two years from date of Festival.
- Your film must be in 16:9 aspect ratio, submitted as an AVI or MP4
- Your film must be submitted and received, no later than 6pm Friday December 13, 2019.
- You can enter as many times as you like.

## **NON COMPLYING ENTRIES**

Entries will be disqualified if:

- Your short film is over eight minutes in length (including titles and credits)
- Your entry arrives any time after the cut off date/time
- Your entry payment has not been received via Film Freeway

## **PLEASE REMEMBER:**

- You must have permission to use published music in your short in the form of a licensed agreement. Peninsula Film Festival strongly recommends you use original or copyright free music in your film to avoid paying licence fees.
- The entrant of the short film must wholly own, or have permission to use, all script, music, characters etc...utilised in entry.
