Stalls must be set up and ready to go by 3pm on the day (Saturday February 10, 2018).

Public liability insurance must be provided to PFF organizers as well as registration number with street traders by December 15, 2017 for local Council approval.

Stallholders to pay PFF prior to the event by January 10, 2018 a fee of \$500 + GST.

The event may be cancelled due to occurrences outside of organizers control such as, but not limited to, bushfire, storms, wild weather.
